

Railer runners headed to state

TOPEKA — The Newton High School boys' and girls' cross country teams are heading back to the state meet after third-place finishes at the Class 5A regionals Saturday at the Shawnee North Community Center in Topeka.

The top four boys' and girls' teams qualify for state.

In the girls' team standings, Topeka Seaman won the meet over Emporia 35-56, Newton was third at 70, and McPherson was fourth at 121.

In the boys' team standings, Emporia downed Shawnee Heights 37-64. Newton was third at 81, and Topeka Seaman was fourth at 95.

Layne Moore of Emporia won the girls' race at 14:49.59, just under two seconds better than Sydney Messic of Topeka Seaman.

The Newton girls were led by Emily Metzler in sixth at 15:43.60. Also claiming medals were Erin Loeffler in 10th in 16:00.39 and Addy Pryor in 13th in 16:11.63. Other Newton runners were Arika Schroeder in 17th at 16:23.35, Lindsey Koland in 24th in 16:59.18, Laurel Woodward in 42nd in 18:13.08 and Kelsey Nachtigal in 45th in 18:16.31.

The boys' race was won by Clay Schneider of Topeka Seaman in 16:40.42, followed by Asher Delmott of Emporia in 17:02.22.

The Newton boys were paced by Scott Isaac, who finished fifth in 17:23.80.

Kevin Leary missed a medal by one spot, finishing 16th in 17:43.77. Zach Metzler was 20th in 18:08.87, followed by Jarrod Will in 21st in 18:11.13, Paul Mosqueda in 26th in 18:30.92, Konrad Quiring in 31st in 18:47.06 and Nathan Troyer in 37th in 19:03.22.

The state meet is Saturday at Rim Rock Farm in Lawrence. The girls' race is at 10 a.m., followed by the boys' race at 11 a.m.
